Subject: Update #4 regarding Planned Parenthood claims

Effective immediately, CCOs should **hold** not yet adjudicated Planned Parenthood claims for CCO members covered by the Medicaid Contract for dates of services on or after July 4, 2025, except for Healthier Oregon Program (HOP) members. This hold applies only to claims not yet adjudicated; CCOs should not reprocess adjudicated claims.

CCOs should continue to process claims for CCO members covered by the separate Non-Medicaid and Oregon Health Plan Bridge – Basic Health Program Contracts and for HOP members covered by the Medicaid Contract.

Why is this happening?

On September 11, 2025, the First Circuit Court of Appeals granted the federal government's request to put on hold the rulings issued in July that directed the government to continue to disburse Medicaid funding to Planned Parenthood while litigation in the case continues.

OHA is analyzing the impact of this court decision and will provide further direction to CCOs as soon as possible.
