Subject: Waiver of CY 2026 CCO Long Term Services and Supports Memorandum of Understanding

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) 2026 CCO contracts:

- Exhibit B, Part 4, Section 8, Paragraph b, Subparagraphs (1-2): These subparagraphs describe the requirement for the CCO to annually submit any updates or revisions to its Long Term Services and Supports Memorandum of Understanding (CCO-LTSS MOU) for review and approval by January 31st of each subsequent Contract Year.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit CY 2026 CCO-LTSS MOU updates/ revisions. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to LTSS in the CY 2026 contracts.

CCO-LTSS MOUs submitted in CY 2025 were reviewed, and feedback was provided to each CCO. A CCO may, at its discretion, submit its updated/revised CY 2026 CCO-LTSS MOU for informational purposes; it will not be reviewed for approval purposes. This decision was made jointly by OHA and the Oregon Department of Human Services to reduce administrative burden while the existing MOUs remain in effect.
