Based upon analysis and recommendations from the Year One review of adult mental health residential standardized rates that became effective July 1, 2019, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) is planning targeted rate adjustments effective with dates of service on and after July 1, 2021.

Why is this happening?

The Year One review helped OHA assess whether the current rate methodology addressed provider inequities to appropriately meet the needs identified through person-centered service planning, residential assessment and service planning processes. In advance of the next rate review, OHA has identified that additional training, technical assistance, and monitoring is needed to better assess ongoing operational and capacity impacts.
