Subject: Care coordination activities report

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement for coordinated care organizations (CCOs):

- OAR 410-141-3860(19): This rule section describes the requirement for CCOs to submit semi-annual reports on their care coordination activities. This requirement was effective January 1, 2020.

OHA hereby waives the requirement to submit care coordination activities reports as set forth in the rule cited above for Contract Year 2020. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirement relating to care coordination as described in the CCO 2.0 contract or in applicable rules.

Please be aware that OAR 410-141-3860(19) will be updated effective January 1, 2021, for changes in the report content and schedule. Each report will be for a six-month period (January-June and July-December) and will be due 45 days after the end of the report period. The first report will be for January 1, through June 30, 2021, and will be due by August 15, 2021. OHA will provide a CCO guidance document for the report by December 1, 2020.

Please note that this report is referenced in the CY 2021 CCO contract in Exhibit B, Part 4, Section 7 b.
