This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) <u>2025</u> CCO contract:

Exhibit I, Section 10, Paragraph b, Subparagraph (3): This subparagraph describes the
requirement for the CCO to submit a sample of Notices of Adverse Benefit Determination
(NOABDs) and the corresponding Prior Authorization (PA) documentation identified by
OHA based on the CCO's quarterly Grievance and Appeal log.

OHA hereby waives the above requirement as applied to the Grievance and Appeal log for the first quarter of CY 2025 (Jan-Mar2025). OHA will not require CCOs to submit a sample of NOABDs and PA documentation. This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to the Grievance and Appeal System in the CY 2025 contract.
