Subject: Waiver of Q4 CY 2025 IIBHT referrals and enrollments report

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) <u>2025</u> CCO contract:

• Exhibit M, Section 22, Paragraph a, Subparagraph (4): This subparagraph describes the requirement for the CCO to submit quarterly reports about Intensive In-Home Behavioral Health Treatment (IIBHT) referrals and enrollments.

OHA hereby waives the above requirement as applied to the IIBHT referrals and enrollments report for the last quarter of CY 2025 (Oct-Dec2025). This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to IIBHT in the CY 2025 contract.

The final IIBHT referrals and enrollments report to be submitted by CCOs is the Q3 CY 2025 report due October 30, 2025. Going forward, OHA will receive IIBHT referral information directly from providers, consistent with OAR 309-021-0150.

OHA will remove the IIBHT referrals and enrollments report deliverable from the CY 2026 contract.
