Subject: Waiver of Annual FWA Prevention Plan and Assessment Report deliverables

This memo is notice of the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA) decision to waive submission of the following deliverables in the Contract Year (CY) [2026](#) CCO contracts:

- Annual Fraud, Waste, and Abuse (FWA) Prevention Plan for CY 2026 in Exhibit B, Part 9, Section 14, Paragraph a.
- Annual FWA Assessment Report about CY 2025 in Exhibit B, Part 9, Section 19, Paragraph d.

Why is this happening?

OHA notified CCOs on [Jan. 26, 2026](#), that the due date for the above deliverables was changed from April 30, 2026, as stated in the contracts, to TBD. OHA has since decided to waive submission of these individual deliverables. This is connected to OHA's goal of providing meaningful and quality reviews of CCO deliverables while managing overall CCO administrative burden.

OHA will provide additional information about the ongoing deliverable redesign effort as part of the 2027 CCO contract restatement process.

What should you do?

CCOs should comply with all other FWA requirements in the CY 2026 contracts.
