**Subject:** Waiver of SDOH Measure elements reporting in CY 2026 Updated HIT Roadmap

This communication is notice of the Oregon Health Authority’s (OHA) decision to waive the following requirement in the Contract Year (CY) 2026 CCO contracts:

- Exhibit J, Section 2, Paragraph d, Subparagraph (9): This subparagraph describes the requirement for the CCO to include in its Updated HIT Roadmap all information collected for Elements 3, 6, 7, and 13 of the Social Determinants of Health: Social Needs Screening and Referral Measure (“SDOH Measure”) for Measurement Year 2025.

**OHA hereby waives the requirement to include the information collected for the SDOH Measure elements specified above in its CY 2026 Updated HIT Roadmap.** This waiver does not relieve the CCO of any other requirements relating to the Updated HIT Roadmap in the CY 2026 contracts.
