Subject: Update #3 regarding Planned Parenthood claims

Effective for dates of service on or after July 28, 2025, CCOs should resume processing Planned Parenthood claims as usual for CCO members covered by the Medicaid Contract. CCOs should continue to hold claims for dates of service July 4, 2025, through July 7, 2025, and July 22, 2025, through July 27, 2025, for CCO members covered by the Medicaid Contract, except for Healthier Oregon Program (HOP) members as noted in OHA’s memo dated [July 24, 2025](#).

Why is this happening?

On July 28, 2025, U.S. District Judge Indira Talwani issued a ruling that directs the federal government to ensure that Medicaid funding continues to be disbursed to Planned Parenthood while litigation in the case continues.

What should you do?

Refer to the table below for a summary of OHA’s direction to CCOs about Planned Parenthood claims by dates of service.

<i>Dates of service</i>	<i>OHA direction to CCOs</i>
Prior to July 4, 2025	Process all claims as usual
July 4-7, 2025	Hold claims for CCO members covered by the Medicaid Contract, except for HOP members
July 8-21, 2025	Process all claims as usual
July 22-27, 2025	Hold claims for CCO members covered by the Medicaid Contract, except for HOP members
On or after July 28, 2025	Process all claims as usual

OHA will continue to share information as it becomes available.
