Per Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act, some member materials must include language access statements in Oregon's Top 15 prevalent non-English languages. For the list of these materials, please see 45 CFR § 92.11. For materials not on this list, language access statements must be in English and all prevalent non-English languages in the CCO service area. OHA uses the <u>Medicaid Enrollment Report</u> to determine languages in the Top 15 list. CMS templates must include Language Access Statements. ☐ Language Access Statements must include: Help is free Other languages and formats are available o Interpreters are available o Customer service number o TTY number 18 pt font size ☐ All **font sizes** are at least 12 point for regular text, 18 point for large text. This applies to all text, including graphics, headers, and footers. ☐ Font color has a contrast ratio of at least 4.5:1 for normal text and 3:1 for large text. You can check contrast ratio of your font colors on WebAIM. ☐ All **URLs are correct** and **hyperlinks are working**. If the document will be printed, URLs are spelled out. ☐ Document includes **CCO branding and contact information**. Subcontractor documents must be co-branded with the CCO.
