

# **Provider Categorization:**The Provider Specialty Matrix



The Provider Specialty Matrix includes all taxonomy codes in the NUCC data set, however *not all provider categories contained* within the matrix will have associated time and distance standards set.



# **Provider Categorization:**The Provider Specialty Matrix

- Developed as a tool to categorize providers and facilities at a level that is meaningful for analysis and monitoring with a focus on access points to care.
  - Example: The Radiology Clinic/Center taxonomy code and Radiologist taxonomy codes are included in the Imaging category but Radiology Assistants working within those centers are not included.
- Uses National Uniform Claims Committee taxonomy codes as the foundation for categorization.
- Informed by CMS Medicare Advantage Taxonomy Crosswalk and expanded to include provider types not monitored by CMS MA using a keyword search algorithm.



### **Provider Specialty Matrix Cont'd**

- Based on a "one-to-many" data relationship structure.
  - This approach enables accurate categorization of providers with multiple applicable taxonomy codes vs a traditional crosswalk that is based on "one-to-one" relationships.
    - Example: an internal medicine physician could be a PCP and have a specialty such as hematology.
- Developed with clinical review and input.
  - Category-by-category review process with Medicaid Medical Directors and BH SMEs with additional review of categories by subject matter experts as needed.
  - Oral Health Categories presented to Oral Health Forum audience at their February meeting.



# **Provider Categorization: The Provider Specialty Matrix - Limitations**

#### NUCC Taxonomy Codes

- The Provider Specialty Matrix is limited to what is available in the current NUCC Health Care Provider Taxonomy Code Set.
- OHA recognizes that there is work to be done to educate providers regarding the importance of keeping their taxonomy codes up to date in the NPI Registry and State and CCO provider enrollment databases.
  - OHA will create short info-guides and communications for providers and explore how to address this during provider enrollment.
  - OHA encourages CCOs to review their provider data maintenance processes to ensure that review of the taxonomy codes with contracted / enrolling providers occurs.



# Provider Categorization: How Will OHA Use the Provider Specialty Matrix?

- OHA will use the Provider Specialty Matrix in its analysis of CCO DSN quarterly Provider Capacity Report submissions for monitoring against network standards and DSN measures.
  - All participating providers in the CCO's network are included in the reporting.
  - The Provider Specialty Matrix will allow for meaningful categorization for monitoring purposes and validation of certain data points (i.e. PCP\_Flag, ages served, individual vs facility/clinic types).
- OHA strongly encourages CCOs to incorporate the Provider Specialty Matrix into their own monitoring processes.
  - Example: Joining the Provider Specialty Matrix to the quarterly DSN submission.




## **Provider Specialty Matrix – Ongoing Maintenance and Use**

- OHA staff will maintain the Provider Specialty Matrix and post it externally for use by the CCOs.
- It is meant to be a "living" tool that will be updated at least twice a year when the NUCC updates its code set and as clinically/operationally appropriate.
- As the quality of provider taxonomy data improves, the utility of the Provider Specialty Matrix to monitor access to particular provider types will also improve.




## **Navigating the Provider Specialty Matrix**



- 1 NUCC Taxonomy Code (<a href="https://taxonomy.nucc.org">https://taxonomy.nucc.org</a>)
- NUCC defined Provider Section: Individual = Individual Provider Type & Non Individual = Facility/Clinic/Business
- 3 Name of provider type per the NUCC Health Care Taxonomy Code Set
- Definition of provider type per the NUCC Health Care Taxonomy Code Set
- Individual Provider vs Non Individual Provider sorting (click arrow at the top of the column to filter)
- Providers serving only pediatric members and those serving only adult members (click arrow at the top of the column to filter)
- Provider categories in alphabetical order (click arrow at the top of the column to filter)

## Navigating the Provider Specialty Matrix, Cont'd



To filter to look at particular provider categories, ages served, etcetera:

- 1. Select the drop down arrow in the column of interest.
- 2. Deselect "(Select All)"
- 3. Select "1"
- 4. Press "OK"
