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# Delivery System Network Updates

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# Current State

- 2023 Quarterly Provider Capacity Report Changes:
  - Data Quality Improvements
    - Removed Provider and Service Categories from reporting.
    - Splitting the report into two sections: Individual and Facility
  - Updated instructions document to reflect the changes made. Significant changes include:
    - Refinement of identifying who “participating” providers are.
    - Additional direction to assist in capturing information about PCP’s:
      - Identify all PCPs, including Specialists designated as a PCP
      - Identify the members a PCP has capacity service, including how many are assigned to that PCP within the network.
      - Identify who the PCP serves, by age.

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# What's Coming Next

- Time and Distance Standards
  - No updates for January 2023 → Working on updates for March 2023
  - Working with internal partners and utilizing technology to inform updates to the standards.
- Provider Specialty Matrix
  - Merges NUCC information (taxonomy and NPI) with the CMS Medicare Specialty cross-walk.
  - Will allow us to better identify specialty types available within CCO networks.
- ArcGIS
  - Mapping system that will allow us to visually see where providers are located, in relation to members.
  - May help in identifying appropriate time and distance standards based on where members and providers are located.
