

Healthier Oregon members moving to OHP Open Card



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What you need to know:

In January 2027, federal changes mean all Healthier Oregon OHP members will move to OHP Open Card.

Oregon provides full OHP benefits regardless of immigration status through a program called Healthier Oregon. Unlike in other states, people in Oregon will not lose OHP due to immigration status.

OHP Open Card (also known as fee-for-service)

- OHP Open Card offers full OHP benefits for people who are not enrolled in a CCO.
- The network of health care providers that take Open Card is different than CCOs. Many providers work with both CCOs and open card.

Coordinated care organizations (CCOs)

- A CCO is a local network of health care providers in your area that work together to care for OHP members.
- Each CCO has a different network of health care providers.

Will I need to find new health care providers?

You can keep seeing any providers that accept Open Card after the transition. Many health care providers work with CCOs and Open Card, but some do not.

Please ask your current health care providers if they accept OHP Open Card. If they do not, also ask for help planning care for the rest of 2026 and around the transition.

If you need to find providers that accept OHP Open Card:

Before Jan. 1, 2027:

- Use the online Open Card provider search tool at OHPOpenCard.org. Please keep checking back as the search tool is improved and new providers join the network.

After Jan. 1, 2027:

- You can call OHP Open Card at 800-562-4620 for help finding providers and coordinating care.
