NEED FOR THE RULE(S):

This rule must clarify and explicitly state that the Authority may apply coverage criteria listed in Statements of Intent and Practice Guidelines (Guideline Notes, Ancillary Guideline Notes, and Diagnostic Guideline Notes) from the Prioritized List to codes and lines not explicitly specified in that guideline note, as well as to services such as diagnostic, ancillary and excluded irrespective of their inclusion on the lines of the Prioritized List.

JUSTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY FILING:

The Authority finds that failure to act promptly will result in serious prejudice to the public interest, the Authority, and recipients of Medicaid benefits. These rules need to be adopted promptly to clarify the correct interpretation and use of Statements of Intent and Practice Guidelines (Guideline Notes, Ancillary Guideline Notes, and Diagnostic Guideline Notes) from the Prioritized List and their application to codes and lines not explicitly specified in that guideline note. This rule change clarifies how the Agency applies the list when making coverage determinations for Oregon Health Plan recipients.

RULE SUMMARY: The OHP program administrative rules govern the Division's payments for services provided to

clients. 410-

141-3830 codifies the Prioritized List of Services used to determine which services are covered for OHP

recipients, including guideline notes containing coverage criteria related to ancillary, diagnostic, and excluded services. 141-3830 applies to all providers of Medicaid services, including Fee-for-Service per the order of precedence rule in Division 120 (410-120-0025).

Prioritized List of Health Services

(1) The Health Evidence Review Commission (HERC) Prioritized List of Health Services (Prioritized List) is the listing of physical health services, oral health and behavioral health services with "expanded definitions" of practice guidelines and sgenerated and maintained by HERC. The Authority may apply criteria listed in Statements of iIntent as presented to the Oregon Legislative Assembly. The Prioritized List is generand Practice Guidelines (Guideline Notes, Ancillary Guideline Notes, and Diagnostic Guideline Notes) from the Prioritized List to codes and lines not explicitly specified in that guideline noted and maintained by HERC services such as diagnostic, ancillary and excluded irrespective of their inclusion on the lines of the Prioritized List. (2) This rule, effective FebrJanuary 1, 20242, incorporates by reference the FebrJanuary 1, 20242 Prioritized List, funded through line 4742 and including all line items, diagnosis and treatment codes, guideline notes, statements of intent, coding specifications and annotations. This Prioritized List dated FebrJanuary 1, 20242 supersedes the January October 1, 2021 Prioritized List for services provided after FebrJanuary 1, 20242, and includes interim modifications reported as required under ORS 414.690(7) and (8).
