Sunset Provisions

(1) The hospital assessment applies to net revenue received by hospitals on or after January 1, 2004, and before October 1, 2019~~25~~. ¶

(2) The Type A and B hospital assessment applies to net revenue received by hospitals on or after January 1, 2018, and before October 1, 2024~~5~~.
