

Overview

In lieu of services (ILOS) are medically appropriate and cost-effective substitutes for covered services or settings under the State Medicaid plan and must meet federal requirements outlined in 42 CFR 438.3(e)(2).

Oregon proposes specific ILOS to Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for approval on an annual basis. Approved ILOS are included in CCO contracts and become available for CCOs to offer to members. There are currently <u>seven approved ILOS available to CCOs</u>.

OHA staff, coordinated care organizations (CCO) and their community partners are **invited to** collaborate in developing Oregon's proposed 2025 in lieu of services (ILOS).

ILOS design sessions


OHA requests your ideas and feedback through a series of topic-based discussions in November and December 2023 called **ILOS pre-design and design sessions**:
