We want your input on rules for OHP coverage for members under 21!

The Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment Program (EPSDT) ensures complete health care coverage for Oregon Health Plan (OHP) members under age 21. Starting in 2023, more things can now be covered for members under 21 because of EPSDT. You can find out more at www.oregon.gov/EPSDT

The Oregon Health Authority is updating the administrative rules for EPSDT. This will help make sure the new requirements about coverage are clear. These rules are laws that the Oregon Health Authority, coordinated care organizations (CCOs), and OHP providers must follow when deciding about coverage for OHP members under age 21.

We would love to have your input! We want these rules to reflect the needs of OHP members under 21 and their families, and the providers and CCOs who serve them. We are looking for OHP members, parents/caregivers, providers, navigators/assisters, CCO staff and others to help us with this. You can choose to:

- Participate in a Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) meeting that will take place in late July or early August 2023. RACs are made up of community members who provide input and suggestions for the rules.
- Set up time to meet with EPSDT staff during Summer 2023. We can meet just with you or your organization. Or we can set up a group listening session at a time that works best for your community.
