Letters sent to Citizenship Waived Medical (CWM) members who moved to full OHP Plus benefits

Starting July 1, 2023, **people of any age or immigration status** may be eligible for full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) benefits regardless of their immigration status.

- This is possible because of <u>House Bill 3352</u> (2021) which put into law a program called "Healthier Oregon."
- All other eligibility requirements still apply.
