Communications to support member transition from Citizenship Waived Medical (CWM) to OHP Plus benefits

Starting July 1, 2022, **people who are 19-25 or 55 and older** may be eligible for full Oregon Health Plan (OHP) benefits regardless of their immigration status.

- This is possible because of <u>House Bill 3352</u> (2021) which put into law a program called "Cover All People."
- The program is now known as <u>Healthier Oregon</u>.

Current CWM members who are 19-25 or 55 and older will automatically move from emergency coverage to full benefits in July.

Sample letters from May 2022 member mailing (OHP 3958A)

Starting May 16, 2022, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will mail letters to CWM members about this change. It also lets them know to expect a phone call from OHP in June.
