In lieu of services (ILOS)

In lieu of services (ILOS) are medically appropriate and costeffective substitutes for covered services or settings under the State Medicaid plan, the Oregon Health Plan.

- Coordinated care organizations (CCOs) are not required to offer ILOS to members.
- CCO members are not required to use the alternative service or setting.

Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) ILOS requirements outlined in 42 CFR 438.3(e)(2).

Billing pathways

 If the ILOS provider has billing infrastructure, ILOS is billed through standard Medicaid claims

- If the ILOS provider is unable to submit a claim, CCOs have the option to:
 - Collect a limited dataset from the ILOS provider
 - Add remaining data needed to create and submit a valid claim

Reduced dataset

- This optional billing pathway was identified to reduce the administrative process of ILOS billing for communitybased organizations without billing infrastructure
- Can be collected from ILOS providers electronically, paper, etc.
 - CCOs are encouraged to work with providers to tailor how ILOS data is collected
- If pursued, CCOs would still need to create a compliant 837 file that meets the national standard X12 transactions and code sets requirements

Reduced dataset elements

- National Provider Identifier (NPI) of billing & rendering provider, except for atypical providers
- Name & Medicaid ID number of member
- Valid diagnosis code(s), procedure code(s) and modifier(s)
- Billed amount for service
- Coordinated care organization (CCO) allowed and paid amounts for service

Billing codes

- Any procedure code that is valid on the date of service and is an accurate representation of the ILOS service provided may be used
- OHA has suggested procedure codes & modifiers for 2023
 Oregon ILOS in the <u>ILOS billing guidance document</u>
- All ILOS claims must include the ILOS-specific modifier "V4" for tracking purposes

ILOS provider requirements

National Provider Identifier (NPI)

- ILOS rendering (service) providers must have a valid and enrolled National Provider Identifier (NPI)
- ILOS billing providers must either obtain a valid NPI or be enrolled as an atypical provider. Atypical providers are not required to have an NPI.

ILOS provider requirements

Division of Medical Assistance Programs identification (DMAP ID)

- Every provider on a claim (rendering and billing providers) must be known to MMIS and have a Medicaid/DMAP ID #.
- As of October 2023:
 - Fee-for-service enrollments are typically processed within ~three months
 Three months
 - Encounter-only enrollments submitted by a CCO are typically processed within one to three days
