# Billing Oregon Health Authority for Medication-Assisted Treatment Medications

This fact sheet describes current fee-for-service reimbursement for Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) drugs administered to Oregon Health Plan (OHP) members.

**For buprenorphine and naloxone billing by eligible providers, use the following codes:**

Code	Description	Rate	Unit
G1028	Take-home supply of nasal naloxone, 2-pack of 8mg per 0.1 ml nasal spray (provided by a Medicare-enrolled opioid treatment program)	\$127.69	Per Service
J0570	Buprenorphine implant, 74.2 mg	\$1,311.75	Per Service
J0571	Buprenorphine, oral, 1 mg	\$1.24	Per Service
J0572	Buprenorphine/naloxone, oral, less than or equal to 3 mg buprenorphine	\$4.66	Per Service
J0573	Buprenorphine/naloxone, oral, greater than 3 mg, but less than or equal to 6 mg buprenorphine	\$8.30	Per Service
J0574	Buprenorphine/naloxone, oral, greater than 6 mg, but less than or equal to 10 mg buprenorphine	\$6.77	Per Service
J0575	Buprenorphine/naloxone, oral, greater than 10 mg buprenorphine	\$16.61	Per Service
J0577	Injection, buprenorphine extended release (Brixadi), less than or equal to 7 days of therapy	\$417.21	Per Service

Code	Description	Rate	Unit
J0578	Injection, buprenorphine extended release (Brixadi), greater than 7 days and up to 28 days of therapy	\$1,668.84	Per Service
J2315	Injection, naltrexone, depot form, 1 mg	\$4.25	Per Service
Q9991	Injection, buprenorphine extended release (Sublocade), less than or equal to 100 mg	\$1,996.56	Per Service
Q9992	Injection, buprenorphine extended release (Sublocade), greater than 100 mg	\$1,996.56	Per Service

## For medication administration:

Bill 96372 for naltrexone or extended-release buprenorphine injection procedures.

## For billing by substance use disorder providers:

Providers need to bill using the drug-specific codes. These may include H0033 and T1502.

## For methadone billing by eligible providers, use the following codes:

Please note: When billing the services below, an Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) may bill both H0020 and S0109 per service.

- H0020 covers dispensing and related administrative services associated with providing methadone treatment, including both onsite administration and take-home dosing.
- S0109 covers methadone medication.

Code	Description	Rate	Unit
S0109	Methadone, 5mg	\$0.18	Per Dose
H0020	Alcohol and/or drug services; Methadone administration and/or services (provision of the drug by licensed program)	\$12.50	Per Service
