

Oregon Health Plan (OHP) Updates



Do you have OHP Dental only?

Starting January 1, 2023, OHP will offer some members dental-only benefits (“OHP Dental”). If page 3 of your OHP coverage letter shows “OHP Dental” by your name:

- The dental benefits are the same as full OHP (“OHP Plus”) for adults.
- OHP dental benefits include teeth cleanings, dental check-ups and x-rays, fillings, tooth removal, emergency dental care, and some dentures.
- “OHP Dental” does not cover physical or mental health care.

Who covers OHP Dental care?

You will get a welcome packet from your coordinated care organization (CCO). It will contain your CCO member ID card and information about covered services.

- The CCO’s name will be on page 4 of your coverage letter. It will show “CCOF” before the CCO’s name.
- You can call your CCO if you have questions about finding a dentist or getting dental care.

Moda Health will cover drugs your dentist may prescribe, such as antibiotics or pain relief medications. You will get a Moda Health ID card in two to three weeks.

Moda Health will **not** cover:

- Refills or prescriptions for more than a 30-day supply.
- Prescriptions for fluoride toothpaste or mouth rinse.

When you fill prescriptions from your dentist:

- Show the Moda ID card to the pharmacist.
- Also show any other cards you have for medical plan coverage. If you have a medical plan, that plan pays for your prescriptions.

If you are American Indian or Alaska Native and do not have CCO:

You can ask to enroll in a CCO for your OHP Dental benefits. Call OHP Client Services at 800-273-0557.

OHP Plus benefits for children and youth up to age 21

OHP covers all services needed for children and youth's health and development. These services are called Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) benefits.

For children and youth under age 21 with full OHP ("OHP Plus"):

- OHP covers any services needed to find or treat illness, injury, or other changes in health.
- Starting January 1, 2023, may cover services OHP didn't cover before, based on the child's personal needs and medical history.
