## **Problem Gambling Prevention Implementation Plan Guidelines**

These guidelines have been developed to inform and assist CMHP/County programs in development of the 2021 Problem Gambling Prevention Implementation Plans in accordance with contractual requirements. The guidelines reflect the minimum requirements that must be included in the plan utilizing the OHA PGS Prevention Implementation Plan document provided.

All plans must include the plan year January – December 2021 from the drop-down menu, the county or program name from the drop-down menu, vision statement, problem statement, and program goal statement. Additional plan requirements:

Plans must include the following:

- A minimum of two objectives with corresponding entries for activities, inputs, outputs, outcomes, CSAP strategies (when appropriate), and social ecology.
- Objectives must reflect the community assessment findings.
- To ensure programs are meeting the Service Element 80 language, one objective must be related to workforce development.

Strategic planning increases the effectiveness of prevention efforts by ensuring that prevention programs select and implement the most appropriate programs and strategies for their communities. This is an opportunity to update your existing plan to reflect the needs of the community and changes based on the impact of COVID-19 on the work. An effective plan should reflect the input of key stakeholders, including community members. Collaborative planning processes are more likely to address community needs and be sustained over time.

The Problem Gambling Implementation Plan is a “living document” and can be updated to reflect changes found necessary for the effective implementation of Problem Gambling Prevention Services at the community level.
