Request to increase diversity and equity in membership for Rules Advisory Committee (RAC)

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) goal is to create more equitable Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs). Organizations can help reach this goal by choosing someone from a priority population to represent their organization.

OAR 950-020-0010(7) defines “priority populations” as:

- Communities of color;
- Tribal communities including the nine federally recognized tribes of Oregon and other American Indians and Alaska Natives people;
- Immigrants;
- Refugees;
- Migrant and seasonal farmworkers;
- Low-income individuals and families;
- Persons with disabilities; and
- Individuals who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or queer, or who question their sexual or gender identity.

OHA’s Health Equity Definition includes “communities historically and currently disadvantaged by their race, ethnicity, language, disability, gender, gender identity,

sexual orientation, social class, intersections among these communities or identities, or other socially determined circumstances.”

Proposed changes for Rules Advisory Committee discussion

Rule(s)	Description of proposed changes
OAR 410-121-0000	Foreword and Definition of Terms – rule clean up, amending “Mental Health Drug” with updated citations for division 141 rule book.
OAR 410-121-0111	P&T committee – Removal of HB 2100 references
OAR 410-121-0145	Prescription Requirements- removing out of date language and provisions no longer needed for emergency contraception.
OAR 410-121-0146	Dispensing Limitations – amending rule to allow dispensing of greater than 34 days for select carve out medications.
OAR 410-121-0147	Exclusions and limitations – rule clean up, amending to remove repealed rule.
OAR 410-121-0155	Reimbursement- to make clear reimbursement rule (and obligation to complete survey) does not apply to IHS Tribal 638 pharmacies paid under AIR. Also, remove language about prescription requirement for pill splitter and diabetic supplies, etc.
