Oregon's Tooth Taxi: A Mobile Dental Clinic Making a Difference

Oregon's Tooth Taxi is a special dental clinic on wheels. The Tooth Taxi travels around the state to help kids who need dental care. This program, run by the Dental Foundation of Oregon, offers free dental services to children who might not be able to visit a regular dentist. According to the Oregon Health Authority, almost half of children in Oregon between six and nine years of age have a cavity. The Tooth Taxi is offering an important service for those who need it most.



Using the Tooth Taxi

The Tooth Taxi visits schools and communities, giving kids dental checkups, cleanings, sealants, and fillings. Before the Tooth Taxi arrives, children are checked by the staff dentist to see who needs help the most. Parents must sign permission forms before any dental work can be done.



Volunteering for the Tooth Taxi

Volunteers, like dentists, dental hygienists, and dental assistants, play a big role in the Tooth Taxi. They help by giving their time and skills to provide dental care to children.
