Get care

Get care where, when, and how you want it. With many options below, you can even skip the trip to your doctor's office.



Online

- **E-visits** – Complete an online questionnaire and receive a treatment plan, including prescriptions if needed, in less than one hour.
- **Secure email** – Message your care team with nonurgent questions.¹
- **Video visits** – Meet face-to-face with a Kaiser Permanente doctor on your computer, smartphone, or tablet.^{2,3}
- **Online resources** – Visit kp.org to manage your health, find nearby locations, and take advantage of health guides and other resources.



By phone

- **Phone visit** – Save yourself a trip to the medical office for minor conditions or follow-up care.⁴
- **24/7 advice** – Call for medical advice and care guidance. We'll help you find out what care is right for you, schedule appointments, and more.



In person

- **Primary and specialty care** – Schedule a primary or specialty care visit with a member of your care team. If you don't need to see your regular doctor, schedule a visit with an available doctor at any of our medical offices. You may need a referral to see certain specialists.
- **Care Essentials® by Kaiser Permanente** – Visit a primary care clinician at our Hawthorne or Pearl District locations. Evening and weekend appointments available. Walk-ins welcome. Visit careessentials.org to learn more.
- **Urgent care** – Visit a walk-in clinic if you have a condition that requires prompt medical attention (usually within 1 or 2 days) but is not an emergency.⁵ Open 7 days a week, including evenings, weekends, and holidays. Visit kp.org/urgentcare/nw to find a facility near you. You're also covered for urgent care while traveling anywhere in the world.
- **Emergency care** – If you ever need emergency care, you're covered – anywhere, anytime.⁶ You can get care at any Kaiser Permanente hospital or any other hospital emergency department.

An emergency medical condition is a medical or psychiatric condition that requires immediate medical attention to prevent serious jeopardy to your health. For the complete definition of an emergency medical condition, please refer to your EOC or other coverage documents.

Making an appointment

Scheduling routine appointments is quick and convenient at kp.org/appointments or via the Kaiser Permanente app.¹ You can view or cancel upcoming appointments and see details on past visits. You can also call Member Services at **1-800-813-2000** (TTY **711**), and we'll help you get an appointment. In many cases, if you call before 3 p.m., you may be able to get a same-day appointment.

Care away from home

Care while traveling

You're covered for urgent and emergency care anywhere in the world.² If you get hurt or sick while traveling, we'll help you get care. We can also help you before you leave town by checking to see if you need a vaccination, a prescription refill, and more. 
