



CALL FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Cultural Competence Continuing Education Training Opportunities

For Health Care Professionals

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Office of Equity and Inclusion (OEI), invites both local and national **trainers/developers of cultural competence continuing education** (CCCE) training opportunities to submit an application to determine if the opportunity meets criteria for OHA's approval of high-quality cultural competency education.

Once approved, these CCCE training opportunities will be made available to 23 health care professional boards in Oregon and other interested parties, through a registry of high-quality cultural competence trainings on the OEI website.

This program is related to Oregon's CCCE law, [ORS 413.450](#), formerly [HB 2611 \(2013\)](#), and permanent rules, [OAR 943-090-0000 to 943-090-0020](#), which impact 23 health care professional boards who authorize more than 23 types of health care professionals (e.g. physicians, nurses, dentists, pharmacists, psychologists, naturopaths, audiologists, social workers, home care workers, emergency medical service providers, etc.) to practice in Oregon.
