

Types of REALD and SOGI updates

HB 4212 COVID Reporting Requirements - REALD Phase 1 providers (effective October 1, 2020)

Updates for health care providers required to begin collecting and reporting REALD data on October 1, 2020:

- Hospitals except for licensed psychiatric hospitals.
- Health care providers within a health system.
- Health care providers working in a federally qualified health center

HB 4212 COVID Reporting Requirements - REALD Phase 2 providers (effective March 1, 2021)

Updates for health care providers required to begin collecting and reporting REALD data on March 1, 2021:

- Health care providers working in or with individuals in a congregate setting (e.g., long term care settings, residential facilities, corrections facilities)
- Health care facilities as defined in [Oregon Revised Statute 442.015\(12\)\(a\)](#):
 - A hospital (including psychiatric hospitals);
 - A long-term care facility;
 - An ambulatory surgical center;
 - A freestanding birthing center;
 - An outpatient renal dialysis facility; or
 - An extended stay center.

HB 4212 COVID Reporting Requirements - REALD Phase 3 providers (effective January 1, 2022)

Updates for all other health care providers required to collect and report REALD data starting January 1, 2022. These include:

- [Phase 1](#) and [Phase 2](#) providers who have not yet begun REALD data collection and reporting for COVID-19 encounters;
- Other health care providers defined in [House Bill 4212 \(1st Special Session\)](#) who do not work in a Phase 1 or Phase 2 health care setting.
