Dear CCO 2.0 RFA 4690-19 SPC:

CareOregon, Inc. requests to withdraw the Letter of Intent (LOI) that it submitted pursuant to the CCO 2.0 Request for Applications 4690-19 on February 1, 2019 for Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties. Along with its LOI, CareOregon included the following statement:

“We believe that the Oregon Health Authority's best option to ensure the continued access to, and coordination of services for Oregon Health Plan members in Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington Counties would be to continue to contract with the CCO currently operating in that service area: Health Share of Oregon. Because of the breadth of Health Share of Oregon's network and the combined strength of its partners, contracting with Health Share would be the least disruptive option for both members and providers. As a result, we support Health Share of Oregon's letter of intent to apply.

However, in order to ensure continuity of care for OHP Members currently served by CareOregon, please also accept this Letter of Intent to Apply for CareOregon, Inc. to serve as a CCO to provide coordinated care to Oregon Health Plan clients.”

At this point, Health Share of Oregon's partner organizations, including CareOregon, have committed to working together to co-develop a single application to submit in response to the CCO 2.0 RFA. We will continue to build upon Health Share's collective wisdom and experience to adapt the existing CCO model at Health Share to better meet the needs of the community we serve. For this reason, CareOregon requests to withdraw its LOI and turn its attention to co-developing a successful Health Share CCO 2.0 Application for Clackamas, Multnomah, and Washington counties.


