ANALYSIS OF CCO ADMINISTRATIVE CONFIGURATION. Within the global budget, each CCO has two major components:

- (A) CCO administered programs and services, and
- (B) contract programs and services.

Outside the global budget, operating under memoranda of understanding, each CCO has two additional major components:

- (C) state/federal carve-out programs and services, and
- (D) non-carve-out programs and services (federal, state, local government, not for profit, and commercial).

(A) and (B) include primary care, specialty care, hospital care, dental, behavioral health, addictions;

long term care settings, etc, are in (C)
