CCO-Medicaid Contracts Effective	August 1


# CCO Letters of Intent to Apply






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

# Communications & Outreach

- During RFA period
  - Fact sheet and [health.oregon.gov](http://health.oregon.gov)
  - Webinars – kicked off March 2<sup>nd</sup> with 475 attendees.
  - Addressing basic facts and misconceptions if they come up
  - Weekly presentations as invited guests
- Planning for client and provider transition communications
- Strong push on weekly communications to staff

# Permanent Rules Process

- Nominations for the Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) due by close of business on April 12.
- The rules advisory committee will likely meet three times in late April and into May, with each meeting lasting two hours. In addition to that time commitment, members will need to read and be prepared to offer advice on about 43 rules.

# Essential Health Benefits Update

*-Benchmarks for the individual and small group market-*

The Governor's Office announced the Essential Health Benefits (EHB) Workgroup members on April 2, 2012.

The work group includes representation from the following:

- Majority of the major commercial health plans
- Insurance agents/brokers
- Mental Health care representative
- Dental care representative
- County representative
- Consumer advocates
- Small business owners
- Liaisons from the OHPB and the ORHIX Board.

# Essential Health Benefits Activities

- First Workgroup Meeting scheduled for April 16<sup>th</sup>, 9-11am in Wilsonville, Oregon.
- Additional meetings through May and June.
- Benchmark analysis conducted by Wakely is in progress with a final analysis due in May pending federal identification of small group plans (May 10<sup>th</sup>).
- Draft recommendations due to be completed by July.
