Oral Health Work Group Charge

The Oral Health Work Group of the Medicaid Advisory Committee is a limited duration work group to advise the committee on developing a framework on defining and assessing oral health access in Medicaid for the Oregon Health Authority. The Oral Health Work Group is charged with developing this framework by addressing the following questions:

1. What are the key factors that influence access to oral health care for OHP members (i.e. how should Oregon define access)?
2. What key data should be used to assess access to oral health services for OHP members (i.e. how should Oregon monitor access to oral health in Medicaid)?
