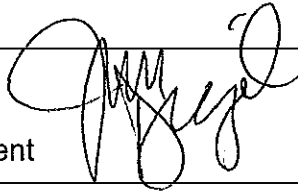

I. PURPOSE AND APPLICABILITY

- A. This policy explains how to save energy and use electrical equipment wisely in state buildings. It also covers personal appliances in work areas, break rooms, and other spaces.
- B. This policy applies to all Staff.

- B. Oregon State Hospital (OSH) follows all rules and laws from the federal government, the state, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Shared Services, and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). If those rules are stricter than this policy, the stricter rules apply.
- C. Staff who do not follow this policy or related rules may face discipline.
