Research Committee

A. **Purpose**

The Research Committee is a sub-committee of, and reports quarterly on research submissions, to the OSH Clinical Administration Team.

The purpose of the Research Committee is to review research protocols, develop contacts and outreach with internal and external researchers, and work with hospital stakeholders in order to confirm support and applicability of research. The Committee carries final responsibility to approve, facilitate, promote and educate staff about research activities at the Oregon State Hospital.
