


Signature Network Access (Statewide)


PEBB Choice Network Access



PCPCH Clinics



- Total PCPCH: 629
- PCPCH In Network: **525**
- PCPCH not In Network: 104
 - Over 100 in Portland Metro area with 91 within 5 provider organizations
 - Cannot meet credentialing or PCP criteria
 - Indian Health Services, School Based Clinic
 - Not interested in being a medical home in the network
 - Other
- 84% of all PCPCH Clinics are in Network
- 53 Medical Homes are Providence Clinics



Providence is the only commercial payer in Oregon to support both CPC classic and CPC+, now underway in 18 regions

- Model designed to:
 - Increase capabilities in primary care
 - Hold practices accountable for performance required will impact total cost of care over time
 - Increase total payments to primary care to meet
 - Shift revenue from FFS to care management fee




- Pay for Performance



- Regional trainings on cultural competency and trauma- informed care in Portland, Salem, Medford, and Bend
- 14 site visits and 5 trainings scheduled for clinics
