4.	<p>PEBB 2019 Medical and Non-Medical Records Renewals (info/<u>action</u>: Bdatt.4) Mercer actuaries Albert, Chen and Kloehn presented PEBB's 2019 Medical and Non-Medical Renewals.</p> <p>ACTIONS: Bill Barr moved to approve Kaiser's request to move into a portion of Lane County, which was seconded by Siobhan Martin. In an oral vote, the motion was approved unanimously, 7-0.</p> <p>DETAILS OF BOARD ACTIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providence Statewide and Choice, and Moda emergency room copays increased to \$150. • Moda will present as a self-insured medical care option in 2019. • Providence Statewide out-of-pocket maximums increase to \$1900/\$5700. • Dependent coverage changes to end the month the dependent becomes 26, rather than the end of the plan year the dependent becomes 26. • Willamette Dental office visit copays increase to \$10 (Bdatt.4, Option 4). • Delta Dental adds coverage for nitrous oxide therapy and simplification of athletic/occlusal night guards benefits. • Kaiser Dental simplifies athletic/occlusal night guard benefits. • VSP will separate combined fitting and evaluation fees to become separate fees and cover standard progressive lenses. • VSP, ASIFlex, Benefit Help Solutions and Cascade Center's renewals have no rate impact for 2019. 	00:56:39 02:29:40 02:31:28

Dana Hargunani seconded the motion and in an oral vote, the motion was passed unanimously, 7-0.</p> <p>Bill Barr moved to accept ASIFlex’s status quo renewal, which Siobhan Martin seconded. In an oral vote, 7-0, the motion was unanimously carried.</p> <p>Siobhan Martin moved to accept Benefit Help Solutions’s status quo renewal. Mark Perlman provided the second.
