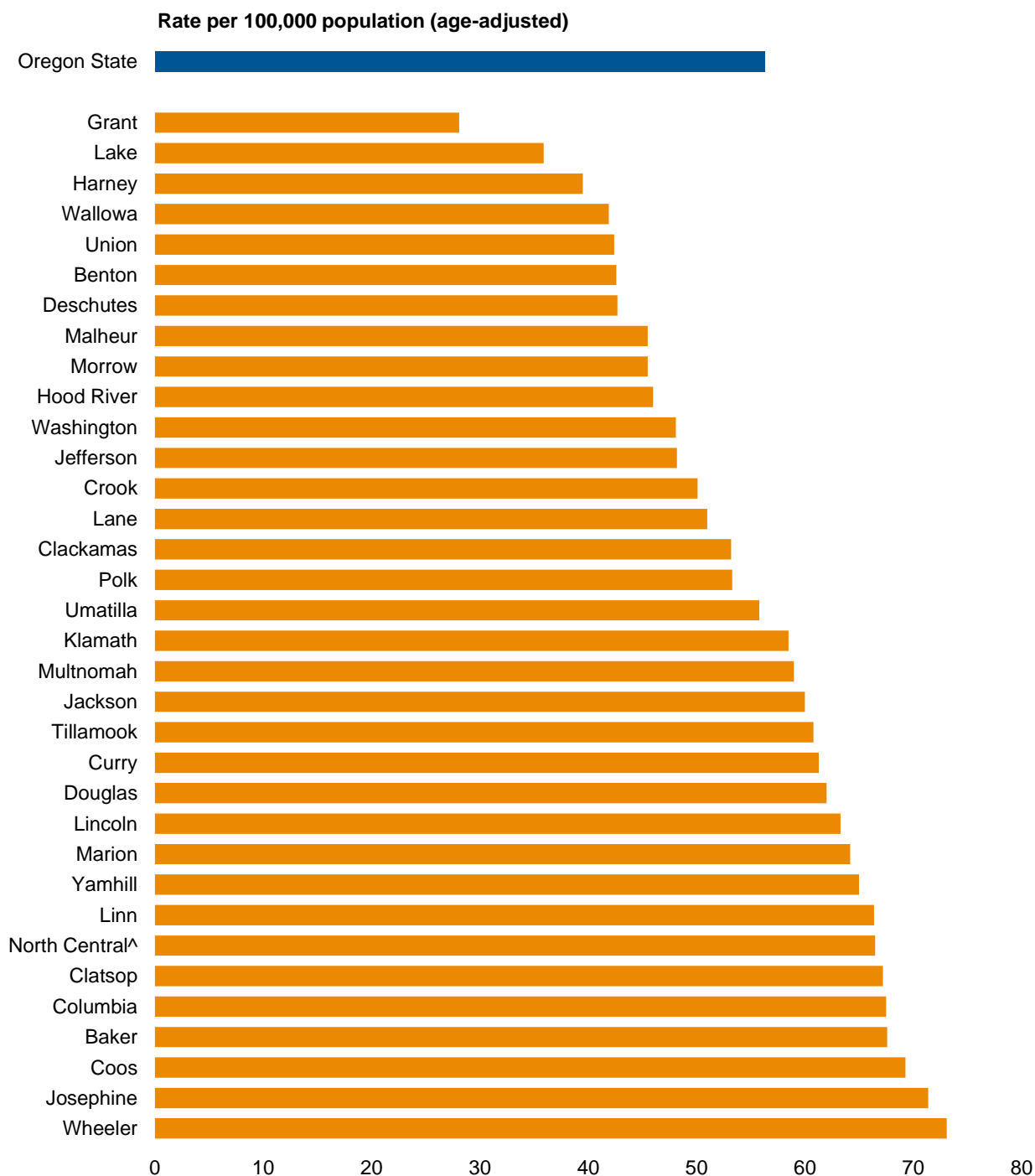


## Invasive lung cancer diagnoses by county, Oregon, 2011–2015
