

Starting January 1, 2026, Oregon law requires death records to be completed in the state's electronic reporting system called OVERS.

[Oregon Revised Statute 432.133(1)(a)]

Funeral directors will no longer have the option to print a paper record for medical certifiers.



OVERS is a secure web-based system that can be accessed using any browser.

## To get an OVERS account, submit the following to Oregon Vital Records.

- 2. Two pieces of ID
