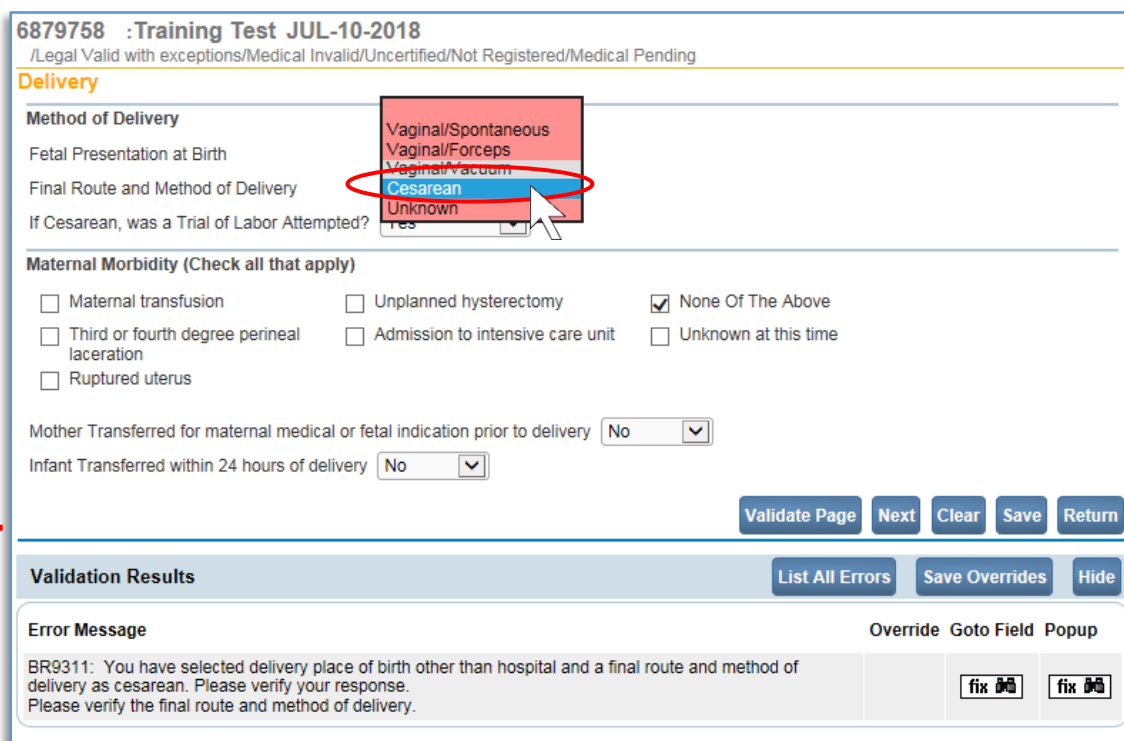


New Edits in Birth Module

Four new edits were implemented in OVERS on September 10, 2018. These new edits appear in the birth module under the Facility section. These edits were added to improve data quality.

1. **Final Route and Place of Birth specifications:** In the Birth Module, on the Delivery page, a red edit will trigger if “Cesarean” is selected from the drop-down list for **Final Route and Method of Delivery** and when the **Place of Birth** is *other* than “Hospital.” A Cesarean can only be done in a hospital. The red edit will prompt the user to change either **Place of Birth** or “Cesarean” method of delivery.

2. **Final Route Cesarean and Attendant Type:** In the Birth Module, on the Attendant/Certifier page, a yellow edit will trigger if the **Attendant Type** selected is *other* than a “Medical Doctor” or “Doctor of Osteopathy” when **Final Route and Method of Delivery** is “Cesarean.” The edit will prompt the user to the correct Attendant Type or final method of delivery. Cesareans should only be attended by a MD or DO. This edit was added to clarify that the user meant to enter the specific combination of **Method of Delivery** and **Attendant Type**.

If override is needed, in the Validation Results section, check the box under “**Override**” and select the “**Save Overrides**” button. The fields will remain yellow but you can continue to the next page.

3. **Attendant Type and Home Birth Selection:** In the Birth Module, on the Place of Birth page, a yellow edit will trigger if any **Home Delivery** options are selected and Medical Doctor or Doctor of Osteopathy is entered as an **Attendant Type**. The edit will prompt the user to correct the **Attendant Type** or the **Place of Birth**. In the case of home births, the birth attendant is not usually a MD or DO. If data entered is correct then an override must be chosen. This edit was added to clarify that the user entering the data meant to enter the specific combination of **Place of Birth** and **Attendant Type**.

4. **Certifier Type and Home Delivery Selection:** In the Birth Module, on under the Attendant/Certifier page, a yellow edit will trigger if **Attendant** is not the same as the **Certifier** and the **Place of Birth** is listed as “Planned Home Birth.” The edit will prompt the user to change **Certifier Name**, **Attendant Name** or **Place of Birth**. The edit can also be saved as an override. This edit was added to clarify that the user entering the data meant to enter a different **Attendant** and **Certifier** when the Place of Birth was listed as a “Planned Home Birth.”
