Changes

In death records:

 Grandparents, grandchildren and siblings cannot order long forms as of 2014 according to Oregon law.

In ID Requirements:

 We have lists for 1 or 3 pieces of acceptable ID. Our list for 2 pieces of ID is no longer valid.

Birth records

Eligibility to order

- Parent
- Parent or 2nd parent, if listed on record
- Step-parent, if married to a parent listed on the birth record and child is under age18
- Registered domestic partner
- Grandparent as long as their child is listed on the record
- Sibling age 18 or older
- Child of registrant, age 18 or older

Who can order a birth certificate?

ORS 432.380(2)(C)(B)(ii)

Birth records

Eligibility to order

- Legal representative with documentation of who they represent and why they are ordering
- Government agencies with documentation and why they are ordering
- Legal Guardian with legal guardianship paperwork
- Non-eligible person with a notarized permission note from an eligible person

Who can order a birth certificate?

ORS 432.380(2)(C)(B)(ii)

Eligibility to order

- Current spouse
- Parent
- Child (over 18 years of age)
- Grandparent
- Grandchild
- Sibling
- Domestic partner who is registered by the state
- Legal guardian with documentation of legal guardianship
- Next of Kin with notarized document stating they are next of kin

Who can order a short form death certificate?

ORS 432.380(3) — ORS 432.380(2)(C)(B)(iii)



Short Form Death Records

Eligibility to order

- Government agency with documentation and why they are ordering
- Legal representative of an immediate family member - with documentation of who they represent and why they are ordering.
- An agency or person who demonstrates a personal or property right reason
- Non-eligible person with a notarized permission note from an eligible person
- Funeral home representative for the first two years after date of event.

Who can order a short form death certificate?

ORS 432.380(3) — ORS 432.380(2)(C)(B)(iii)

Eligibility to Order

- Current spouse
- Parent
- Child (over 18 years of age)
- Domestic partner who is registered by the state
- Legal guardian with documentation of legal guardianship
- Next of Kin with notarized document stating they are next of kin

Who can order a long form death certificate?
ORS 432.380(8)(a)

Eligibility to Order

- Government agency with documentation and why they are ordering
- Legal representative of an immediate family member - with documentation of who they represent and why they are ordering
- Non-eligible person with a notarized permission note from an eligible person
- Companies paying death benefits
- Funeral home representative for the first two years after date of event.

Who can order a long form death certificate?

ORS 432.380(8)(a)

Recap

- These family members can <u>not</u> order long form death records without proper documentation
- Sibling
- Grandparent
- Grandchild

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ID Requirements

- 1. Current, valid passport.
- 2. Current, valid out-of-state driver's license or ID card.
- 3. Current, valid Oregon driver's license, permit, or ID card.
- 4. Current student ID card with name and picture (high school students only).
- 5. Tribal membership or ID with photo and address.
- 6. US alien registration card with photo.
- 7. Armed services ID card with photo.
- 8. Consulate card (Matricula Consular) with photo and address.
- 9. Citizen ID with photo.
- 10. Permanent resident card with photo.
- 11. State of Federal government ID badge with photo.

ONE of the following



ID Requirements

OR any THREE of the following documents, as long as one shows a current address:


- Official papers issued by courts with name and date of birth
- Official Corrections Department or parole papers
- 3. Vehicle registration or title
- Personalized check, or savings account statement
- 5. Monthly account statement (documents must be no more 30 days old)
- 6. Pistol or firearms permit
- 7. State hunting or fishing license
- Utility or other bill with current address (documents must be no more than 30 days old)
- Paycheck stub or paycheck (documents must be no more than 30 days old)

- 10. Selective Service card of military discharge paper (must be original)
- 11. US Immigration or naturalization papers.
- 12. Concealed weapon permit with photo
- 13. Company identification card
- 14. Voter registration card issued by a county elections department
- 15. Valid food stamp, welfare, or unemployment identification Medical or hospital card of identification
- 16. Tax statements W-2 forms, etc. (current year)
- 17. Auto insurance policy (current year)
- 18. Union membership card



- When security paper should be voided, send an e-mail to Kelly listing the voided paper numbers.
 - Security paper needs to be voided when a customer is returning the original for replacement, and when it gets ruined or destroyed in the printing process.
- Don't forget to shred the original certificates issued which have now been replaced.
