When you certify a death record electronically **YOU HELP:**

The families of the deceased.

Families are able to get the death certificate three times faster. This gives them quicker access to social security and death benefits so they can pay for the funeral and other expenses.



Increase the speed and accuracy of death records.

Records are filed immediately and built-in edits catch errors that would otherwise require amendments.

Electronic records don't need to be printed and hand-delivered to the hospitals and to the counties, cutting down paper waste and CO2 emissions.



Uphold the law.

Oregon law requires that facilities with more than ten deaths a year file all death records electronically. (ORS 432.133)
