# DATA TABLES INTRODUCTION

The 2025 Student Health Survey (SHS) provides important data that can improve our understanding of the challenges students face. The findings from the SHS can be used to bridge the gap in understanding between students and the adults and communities who support them to ensure that Oregon provides a safe, supportive, and equitable environment where all youth can thrive.

**Results for State of Oregon are provided in these data tables. These data tables show results by grade (6th, 8th, and 11th) and combined across all grades.**

These data tables show your school results by grade, compared to the statewide results. A table is included for every question in the survey, as well as for calculated variables (e.g.: PYD Benchmark) and recoded or collapsed responses (e.g.: has a disability/does not have a disability).

# DATA TABLES

This section features results by grade for each question on the survey. A table is also included for calculated variables/recodes.

These tables show the percentage that marked each possible response for each question. Calculated variables or recodes show results in a different way, such as combining responses (e.g., percentage of students who have one or more disabilities vs. those with no disabilities) or basing percentages on a subset of respondents (e.g., percentage who drank 5 or more drinks in a row in past 30 days only among those who drank alcohol in past 30 days).

The 6th and 8th grade surveys included a subset of the questions from the 11th grade survey. Data for questions that did not appear on the 6th or 8th grade version are shown as “n/a” (not applicable). Response categories for questions with no respondents will show “0.0”.

# APPENDIX I: METHODOLOGY AND SURVEY PARTICIPATION

The 2025 SHS was designed to be administered online to 6th, 8th and 11th graders statewide in one classroom period to provide state- and county-level estimates.

In 2025, all districts were included in the sampling frame and were invited to participate regardless of enrollment. The following types of schools were excluded from the sampling frame:

- State run schools/Schools with no associated school district, such as:
  - » Juvenile justice facilities
  - » Treatment facilities
  - » Boarding schools

ORS 431.132 requires districts to make the SHS available to students. Students may choose not to take the survey or may refuse to answer any question on the survey. Since the survey covers a comprehensive range of health-related topics, some of the questions can be considered sensitive. There are opportunities for districts, parents/guardians and students to choose whether or not to participate.

SHS uses an active notification/passive consent model for the survey. Once district approval is received, schools send Parental Notification letters to parents and guardians at least two weeks prior to survey administration to inform them of the upcoming survey and provide an opportunity to opt their student out of the survey. Parental Notification letters were available in English, Spanish, Russian, simplified Chinese, Vietnamese and Somali. Students can also choose to opt themselves out of the survey or to skip over any question they do not want to answer.

## OTHER IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- The online surveys were available in English and Spanish and had a Flesch-Kincaid Grade level of 6 (reader needs a grade 6 level of reading or above to understand it):
  - » 6th grade: 6.0
  - » 8th grade: 5.9
  - » 11th grade: 6.4
- The longer the survey, the higher the drop-off (i.e., non-response) for questions that are towards the end. To minimize this, some question topics were rotated on a random basis:
  - » Positive Youth Development, School Climate, and Bullying
  - » Access to Care
  - » Mental Health
  - » Sexual health
  - » Alcohol, Marijuana, and Tobacco
  - » Injury and Violence Prevention
- School-and district-level data are unweighted.
- The data are weighted by enrollment for state- and county-level estimates. State results are weighted to account for lack of participation from the two non-participating counties.
