² Abortion estimates are based on reports for Oregon residents whether occurring in Oregon or another state. For years prior to 1988, abortion estimates were based on Oregon occurrences only, but included abortions obtained by out-of-state residents. Because some neighboring states do not report abortions to the state of residence (especially California), this results in minimal estimates for both abortions and pregnancies.
