

HOW DO I REPORT MY PATIENT'S CANCER DIAGNOSIS OR TREATMENT TO OSCaR?

Your patient has cancer diagnosed or treated.

You represent a pathology laboratory?

- If yes, contact OSCaR at OSCaRCancerTeam@ohsu.edu for current lab reporting process.
- If no, skip to next question.

You represent a hospital?

- If yes, does the hospital have less than twenty five beds?
 - If no, contact OSCaR at OSCaRCancerTeam@ohsu.edu for existing process for fully abstracted, hospital tumor registry case submissions.
- If yes, will the hospital be contracting for case abstraction services with another hospital tumor registry, case abstraction vendor or individual case abstraction contractor (ODS-C)?
 - If no, contact OSCaR at OSCaRCancerTeam@ohsu.edu about the Web Plus abstracting module Small Hospital Template.
- If yes, will the contractor need reporting software?
 - If no, patient cases will be abstracted and submitted to OSCaR according to agreements between your hospital and contractor.
- If yes, contact OSCaR at OSCaRCancerTeam@ohsu.edu about the Web Plus abstracting module Contractor Template.

- If no, contact OSCaR at OSCaRCancerTeam@ohsu.edu about the Web Plus abstracting module Non-Hospital Template.
