#### Q Center Smokefree Center Policy

Q Center is proud to be a smoke and tobacco-free facility. We recognize the need for community spaces to foster safe and healthy environments that empower community members to mitigate chronic disease and live healthy lives.

Smoking and the use of other tobacco products are not allowed on the property of Q Center, both indoors or outdoors, at all times. Tobacco sales, distribution, and advertising are also not allowed.

# Tobacco in LGBTQ Communities

**LGBTQ** stands for **Lesbian**, **Gay**, **Bisexual**, **Trans**, **Queer or Questioning** and has become an umbrella term representing a wide range of sexual and gender identities.
