Patient and caregiver may jointly possess	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 mature plants • 12 immature plants¹ 	
1. Grow site address that is patient's residence where that patient or that patient's caregiver is the designated grower for the patient	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 mature plants per patient • 12 immature plants per patient (regardless of height) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 personal plants may be grown if non-cardholder lives at address, but still cap of 12 mature plants. • No more than 12 mature plants and 24 immature plants (regardless of height) no matter the number of patients². • No size definition on these immature plants. • A grow site in this category cannot qualify for a grandfathering.
2. PRMG at grow site within city limits & zoned residential	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 mature plants • 24 immature plants 24 inches or more in height • 72 immature plants less than 24 inches in height 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A household at a grow site in this category is permitted to have 4 personal plants in addition to the medical marijuana plants.
3. PRMG at grow site registered before 1/1/15 & within city limits & zoned residential (grandfathered grow site)	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 mature plants • 48 immature plants 24 inches or more in height • 144 immature plants less than 24 inches in height 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In order for a grow site to be considered "grandfathered" it must meet certain criteria and be approved by OHA. • A household at a grow site in this category is permitted to have 4 personal plants in addition to the medical marijuana plants.
4. PRMG at grow site outside city limits or inside city limits but not zoned residential:	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 48 mature plants • 96 immature plants 24 inches or more in height • 288 immature plants less than 24 inches in height 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A household at a grow site in this category is permitted to have 4 personal plants in addition to the medical marijuana plants.

5. PRMG at grow site registered before 1/1/15 & outside city limits or inside city limits but not zoned residential (grandfathered grow site)	No more than: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 96 mature plants • 192 immature plants 24 inches or more in height • 576 immature plants less than 24 inches in height 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In order for a grow site to be considered “grandfathered” it must meet certain criteria and be approved by OHA. • A household at a grow site in this category is permitted to have 4 personal plants in addition to the medical marijuana plants.

NOTES:

- Plant limits for immature plants that are less than 24 inches in height are effective October 1, 2018.
- Senate Bill 1544, section 6, which passed in the 2018 legislative session, required OHA to set limits on plants that are less than 24 inches in height.
- If the registration of a PRMG designated at a grow site that was grandfathered under ORS 475B.831(3)(b) or (4)(b) is suspended or revoked and they re-register, subsequent plant limits at an address within city limits and zoned residential will be: no more than 12 mature plants, no more than 24 immature plants 24 inches or more in height and no more than 72 immature plants less than 24 inches in height.
- If the registration of a PRMG designated at a grow site that was grandfathered under ORS 475B.831(3)(b) or (4)(b) is suspended or revoked and they re-register, subsequent plant limits at an address outside city limits or not zoned residential will be: no more than 48 mature plants, no more than 96 immature plants 24 inches or more in height and no more than 288 immature plants less than 24 inches in height.
