MEDICAL MARIJUANA INFORMATION BULLETIN 2025-02

Subject: New Rules Effective January 1, 2026

On January 1, 2026, OMMP's rule revisions related to patients, caregivers, growers, dispensaries, and processing sites will become effective.

All grow sites consent forms will be required to be notarized. A grow site consent form is required from the property owner if a patient or grower does not own the property where the grow site will be located. Notarized consent forms will also now be required if the applicant for a processing site does not own the property where the processing site will be located. Information bulletin 2025-01 details information around this change. The new consent form can be found on the Medical Marijuana Forms page.

Other rule changes include:

- Prohibiting medical marijuana dispensaries from being located within 1,000 feet of a public prekindergarten, kindergarten, or parochial program.
- Adding rules regarding co-location of licensed hemp and medical marijuana grow sites on the same property.
- New rules around product recalls.
- Modifications to rules related to how an application and when payment is to be submitted for dispensary and processing sites. In addition, when a refund of the registration fee may be made to dispensaries and processing sites.
