MEDICAL MARIJUANA INFORMATION BULLETIN 2020-04

Subject: Temporary Rules Adopted for Registrants Effected By Oregon Wildfires

The Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) is adopting temporary rules to assist those that have been affected by the Oregon Wildfires. The full text of the rule change can be found on the OMMP Rules and Statute page under the [Temporary Rules](#) section. The temporary rules are in effect from October 22, 2020 through April 19, 2021.

If you are a currently registered OMMP patient, caregiver or grower and had your OMMP card lost or damaged due to the wildfires in Oregon, you may request a replacement card for no fee. To request a replacement card, submit a written request by mail or email and include your name, date of birth, mailing address, which card is needing to be replaced and a brief statement on how you were affected. OMMP contact information is at the bottom of this bulletin.

Patients: It is important that you contact OMMP if any changes to your registration are needed due to the wildfires in Oregon. If you need to change your caregiver, grower, or grow site, please submit a change form and indicate on the form the change is needed due to the Oregon wildfires and the replacement card fee will be waived. If you are changing grow site locations, consent forms from the property owner are still required.

Growers: If you plan to stop growing, it is important you submit a written request by mail or email to be removed from a registration to the contact information below. Given that most growers are required to track and report, it is important that registration information be kept up to date. If you are required to report in OMMOS, you must still report each month even if there is no onsite inventory or transfers made for the month. When contacting OMMP to be removed from a registration, be sure to include your name and date of birth, so OMMP can confirm who the request is coming from, along with the grow site address. If additional information is needed, OMMP will reach out to the person making the request.
