02/03/21 Meeting

[HB 2997](#) is mentioned which puts together a workgroup consisting of OLCC, OHA, DOR, and governor's office to work with the OCC to further develop the goals. Plan to keep working on subcommittee work until goal of the model bill is reached by the end of the year.

[SB 95](#) does appear to relate to liquor and cannabis sales, no personal data, just sales.

[National Cannabis Regulator Association](#) started, now 20-ish states have joined the association, help share best practice and onboard new legalization states.

[HB 2996](#), the OLCC's effort to bring the 3 patients under the OLCC.

City of Portland [CPOT](#) is working on this issue of education for non-medical counter workers.

OLCC reduced limits they violated ORS [475B.020\(7\)](#) as they made a change that affected OMMP patients.

[SB 157](#), sunset on medical tax, assume another bill will be submitted to reinstate it.

[HB 2445](#) and [SB 157](#) do have the medical patient tax exemption, trying to get more information.

[ORS 475B.139](#), processing for medical purposes and associated OARs.

[OAR 845.025.3305](#), processing for cardholders, outlines limits and conditions. 24oz max per transaction, and no more than 3lb in any 12-month period. Processor may not transfer more back per transaction.

Review max transfers from [OAR 845.025.3305](#).

Permanent cards are in a bill draft now (*see introduced text, [SB 758](#) section 8, as of 02/24/21*).
