

# SERVICE NEEDS OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV

Oregon's Medical Monitoring Project (MMP) asks medical and social service needs across 16 service categories:

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Medical – such as HIV case management, help with medications, dental care, mental health, and substance use counseling

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Social Services – such as public assistance, transportation, and housing

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**55%** have an unmet need

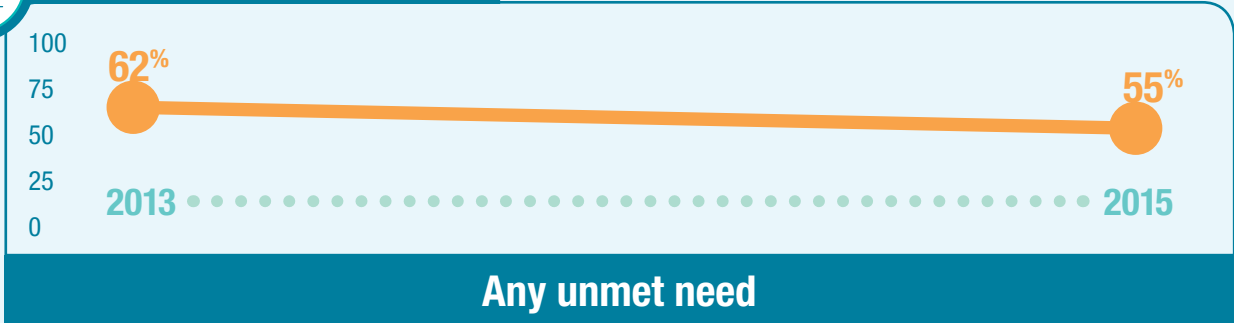
*of those ...*

- 39%** report at least one unmet medical need
- 37%** report at least one unmet social service need

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## Trends in unmet need



**Dental care is the most common unmet need**

**15%** have unmet public assistance need

**8%** have unmet housing services need



# PLWH can achieve viral suppression by taking daily medicine (ART) & engaging in medical care.

- Non-injection drug use
- Injection drug use
